William L. (Bill) Randall, Ed.D., is retired Professor of Gerontology at St. Thomas University (STU) in eastern Canada. Educated at Harvard, Princeton Seminary, and the University of Toronto, he taught at STU from 1995 to 2022. During this period, he helped to pioneer the field of Narrative Gerontology. He has over 70 scholarly publications, including ten books. These include *The Stories We Are* (Toronto, 1995/2014), *Reading Our Lives* (Oxford, 2008), and *The Narrative Complexity of Ordinary Life* (Oxford, 2015). A Taos Institute Associate and a former protestant minister, he is interested in late life spiritual development, in “narrative care” with older adults, and in aging as adventure.
